

Environmental Policy Statement



Versalift United Kingdom Limited recognises the impact we may have on the environment and our obligations to protect it. We have implemented processes and controls to monitor and mitigate negative environmental impacts, with targets for continuous improvement.

This is achieved by the active empowerment of employees, the building of relationships with our supply chain and operating within the framework of the company's *HSEQ Business Management System (BMS)*.

The *HSEQ BMS* is a framework of processes and includes documented procedures, built around the principals and requirements of *ISO 14001: 2015*. The framework provides specific instruction and guidance to employees and suppliers on their individual responsibilities and authority when undertaking activities on behalf of *Versalift United Kingdom Limited*.

In support of this, the objectives of the organisations, employees, supply chain and sub-contractors are to;

- Meet and where appropriate exceed the requirements of the *HSEQ BMS* framework.
- Establish and continually review performance to documented environmental objectives and targets.
- Continually improve our environmental procedures to mitigate any negative impact on the environment, reducing our use of natural resources and preventing pollution.
- Comply fully, and where appropriate, exceed standards set in UK and Ireland regulatory requirements and codes of practice.
- Consider the environmental effects of our raw material consumption, and in particular the sustainable use of recycled materials wherever possible.
- Through strategic planning, we will re-assess the environmental impact of all new developments and include environmental considerations in all investment decisions.
- Reduce waste created by our operations and utilise recycling of waste were reasonably practicable to do so, therefore reducing waste to landfill.

We strive to continually improve the effectiveness of the *HSEQ BMS* framework by setting measurable objectives, analysing feedback, and acting on the results.

In accordance with the UK government's own targets to achieve carbon net zero by 2050, we shall stive to actively reduce our carbon emissions, so far as is reasonably practicable, progressively to aid the governments to achieve their overall net zero targets.

A management review and internal audit process is used to monitor and measure the achievement of business objectives and targets, and to ensure we deliver continual improvements of our environmental performance.
